As Part of the Nationwide Voter Activation: "March On The Polls 2018"
To Celebrate 1st Time Voters and Inspire Voter Turnout Throughout the U.S.**

What:

Thousands of citizens at sites throughout the Country will gather to March On The Polls, as part of a nationwide, women-led movement to increase early and diverse voter turnout for the 2018 Midterm Elections. It is a concerted effort to reach 1st time voters, infrequent voters, young adults and voters in rural areas and communities of color.

When:

Friday-Sunday, October 26-November 6th, 2018. Please see attached for times, locations, descriptions of local activities, rallies, celebrations for 1st time voters, and events for people to cast their ballots early at the polls and on Election Day.

Who:

March On The Polls local, grassroots organizers along with community and national partners including, Swing Left, March For Our Lives/Parkland, Rock The Vote, NAACP, La Raza, churches, clergy, Black Student Union, Historical Black Colleges, and other organizations specific to each location.

Where:

Oct 26-28: Georgia – Atlanta, Macon, Savannah, Albany and Columbus; Mississippi – Jackson, Vicksburg, Fayette; and, nearly 30 sites throughout Houston & San Antonio; Wash, D.C.; Baltimore, MD & more

Nov 2-6: Calif – Inglewood/Los Angeles, Lancaster, Oakland, Ventura; New York City; Flint, MI; Selma, MI; Washington, DC; North Dakota; Houston, TX; Sherwood, WI; Orlando, FL; Mississippi – Holy Springs, Greenwood, Cleveland

Special Considerations and Notes to Editor:

Photos and Video available; audio and photography permitted during rallies, community events and marches, but not inside voting booths; there is b-roll/photos of nationwide March On The Polls events.
